Rüdiger Krause is Professor for Civil Law and Labour Law and Director of the Institute for Labour Law at the Faculty of Law, Georg-August-University Göttingen, Germany. He has written some 160 books, articles and comments mainly in the field of German and European Employment and Labour Law. He is the author of the report for the 71. German Lawyers Conference (“Deutscher Juristentag”) on the digitization of work (“Digitalisierung der Arbeitswelt – Herausforderungen und Regelungsbedarf”, 2016) and of two other reports for German Ministries of Labour at federal level on employee data protection (2017) and at state level on public procurement (2019). He is co-editor of the German Journal “Soziales Recht” (since 2011).

Rüdiger Krause is frequently visiting professor at the Eötvös-Loránd University Budapest and gave lectures in Austria, Belgium, Canada, China, Italy, Japan, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Taiwan, U.K. and the U.S. He is member of the Board of the German Association of Labour Courts (“Deutscher Arbeitsgerichtsverband”) and the German Section of the International Society for Labour and Social Security Law. He is part of the EU-funded project “Smarter industrial relations to address new technological challenges in the world of work”.
